Venue Announcement for City V Country 2009

Country Rugby League Chief Executive Officer Terry Quinn has announced Orange's Wade Park as the venue for the 2009 Country-City Origin Clash. The representative fixture scheduled for Friday May 8, makes a welcome return to the Western Region after two years at coastal venues (2007 Coffs Harbour, 2008 Wollongong).

"The proposal submitted by Orange City Council was very impressive," said Quinn. Quinn emphasised that all four rugby league clubs, Orange CYMS senior and junior, Bloomfield Junior Rugby League and Orange Hawks, will be involved and benefit from the fixture.

"The CRL looks forward to working with both the junior and senior Orange clubs to promote rugby league not only in Orange itself but across the Western Region and Country New South Wales." It will be the second high profile match played in Orange in the less than 18 months with the city successfully staging a National Rugby League match between Canberra Raiders and Brisbane Broncos in February.
