Outback Challenge played at Warren Saturday 25th July 2009

After a high standard and entertaining affair the Queensland team defeated NSW Country Rugby League in the Outback Challenge played at Warren on Saturday.

The Queenslanders twice had to come from behind in the first half before establishing an 18 to 10 lead at half time before going on to take the game 36 to 26.

CRL's rangy centre Cody Café registered first points in the game when he scooped up an optimistic QLD pass that went astray and he managed to force his way over for a converted try in the 13th minute. QLD soon replied after to make it 6 all.

Flying Dunedoo speedster Adam Chapman increased the CRL lead to 10 to 6 when he was on the end of some good hands along the backline. The QLD backs replied in kind and went back to back in the scoring after some good off loads giving the visitors a handy 18 to 10 lead going into the break.

CRL forward Tim Stone crashed over in the 55th minute of the game for a converted try and a score line that read 18 to 16.

However the CRL comeback was relatively short lived and tries to a dominant QLD outfit saw them race out to a 36 to 16 lead with nine minutes remaining.

While the remaining minutes were claimed by the CRL side with Chapman crossing twice more to claim a treble, it was not enough, leaving the final score at 36 to 26.

Warren's Matt Hall, the CRL five eighth, was nominated by the QLD side as the best opposition player with Gulgong's Aaron Weatherly and Gilgandra's Adam Hazelton both handing in impressive displays up front for the CRL team.

Quinton Marshall of Mt Isa was nominated as the QLD player of the match.
